

### **Learning to Live Like Jesus** **Listening to the Sermon on the Mount and Other Teachings of Jesus**

If we are going to be people of Jesus and wear his name, we need to pay close attention to what he taught. Using the Sermon on the Mount as a starting point, the objective of this class is to examine, and ultimately adopt in our lives the ethic, that is the way of living, to which Jesus calls his people. At the end of the Sermon, Jesus tells us to be doers of the words he has just spoken. Earlier, He says we should exceed the righteousness of the Pharisees. While these admonitions may seem intimidating, we will examine what they should mean in our lives - focusing primarily on the 164 or so hours a week we are not together as a body. We will also consider these admonitions remembering that Jesus also said, "My yoke is easy and my burden light." Jesus is not asking for the impossible, but he does want us to listen.
