Blessing Bags COLLECTING DONATIONS NOW THROUGH 11/9

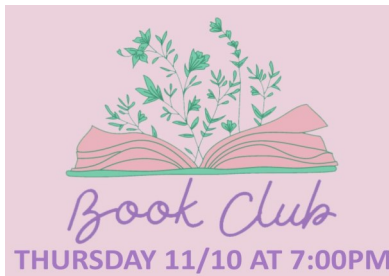
