We will study balms, spices, and essential oils of the Bible for the winter quarter. 33 essential oils or aromatic oil producing plants are mentioned in the Bible. The word "oil" is mentioned 191 times in scripture. We mostly read right over them, considering them "background" to the story. However, every word of scripture is "God breathed" and there are layers of lessons within the mentions of the oils and faith.

- A few of the things we will learn are why frankincense and myrrh were given by the Wise Men.
- The purpose of the Good Samaritan pouring oils and wine on the travelers wounds.
- Why the woman anointed Jesus feet with expensive perfume (spikenard).
- How and why people were anointed.
- Why we should anoint and pray for healing.
- Why God prescribed incense to be used in the Tabernacle and Temple.

We have learned God's oils are just as useful to us today as they were to people in Bible times.
